7:05 Review of the September 10, 2018, Meeting Minutes

Mr. Narayana made a motion, seconded by Ms. Van Lancker to accept the September 10, 2018, Meeting Minutes as amended. Motion passed 4-0-0.

7:09 2019 Meeting Dates Calendar

The Agent stated that there is a 2019 calendar to determine the meeting dates for 2019. The Agent stated that this should be continued until a full board is present, and recommended that the four present members look at their calendar, as this will be revisited at the next Conservation Commission Meeting.

7:10 Policies and Procedures

The Agent stated that Mr. Moulton had previously suggested creating policies and procedures for certain situations that arise. The Agent specifically mentioned tree removal, but stated that there are other instances that should have their own policies and procedures. The Agent recommended to the Commission to start thinking of such instances to allow policies and procedures to be drafted.

7:11 Request for COC, 95-847, Richmond Development, 6 Tydeman Road, single family home

The Agent stated that the work was done in compliance with the Order of Conditions and with the approved plans.

Mr. Narayana made a motion, seconded by Ms. Van Lancker, to issue a Complete COC for 95-847, for 6 Tydeman Road. Motion passed 4:0:0.

- 44 Ms. Jennifer Ball (Assistant Town Manager), Ms. Tiffany Card (Representative- Green
- 45 International Affiliates, LLC), and Ms. Danielle Spicer (Representative- Green International
- 46 Affiliates, LLC.), were present for the hearing.

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- 48 Ms. Ball stated that there are two amendments that are proposed within this hearing. Ms. Ball
- 49 explained that when the permit was first issued, the plans showed the trail going onto 24
- 50 Sudbury Road, but the Notice of Intent did not include that property. The first amendment
- deals with adding 24 Sudbury Road. Ms. Ball stated that Green International will explain the
- second amendment.

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- Ms. Card stated that part of the amended deals with the method of installation for the large
- span bridge located at Mill Pond Park. Ms. Spicer explained that it would be brought in and
- 56 placed on temporary supports that would be in place for two to four weeks. The footings will
- 57 not require dredging, excavation or removal of water.

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- The Commission asked about the material of the pilings for the bridge. Ms. Spicer explained
- 60 that it would likely be steel. The Commission asked about the span of the bridge. Ms. Spicer
- stated that it would be about 170 feet in length.

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- Mr. Ray Trainor (84 Sudbury Road) stated that he works in construction and asked if the EPA
- has been notified of the work. Ms. Ball stated that EPA has been informed of the work, and
- 65 that they have issued initial comments. Green International stated that they cannot remove any
- 66 contaminated soil from the water. Mr. Trainor asked about the purpose of the footings. Ms.
- Spicer stated that the footings decreased the overall cost of the project.

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- 69 Mr. Lingham stated that EPA comments should be obtained. Mr. Lingham said he did not
- have a concern of the temporary footings, and recommended that silt curtain be added as a
- 71 condition of the Amended Order of Conditions.

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- 73 Mr. Trainor asked about who will monitor the project. Ms. Ball stated that the Conservation
- 74 Agent will do inspections.

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- Ms. Vicky Johnson (43 Sudbury Road) stated that she had some comments, but she will take it
- out of the meeting and speak to Green International Affiliates separately.

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- 79 Mr. Narayana made a motion, seconded by Ms. Van Lancker, to close the hearing. Motion
- 80 passed 4:0:0.

- 83 Mr. Steve Hickey (Applicant- Richmond Development) was present for the meeting. The
- Agent stated that there is a condition in the Order of Conditions prohibiting the issuance of any
- 85 Certificate of Compliance if the open space land is not given to the Conservation Commission,
- 86 it shall be put in a Conservation Restriction.

- 88 Mr. Hickey stated that he is going to Fall Town Meeting for the acceptance of the subdivision
- and land, and that the Town would likely require that this be closed prior to the acceptance of
- 90 the subdivision and open space.

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- 92 Ms. Van Lancker made a motion, seconded by Mr. Narayana, to issue a Complete COC for 95-
- 93 848, for the Tydeman Road subdivision. Motion passed 4:0:0.

- 97 The Agent stated that Request for an Extension Order of Conditions was submitted by VHB to
- 98 extend the permit for three more years.

- 101 Order of Conditions. Motion passed 4:0:0.

- The Agent stated that an Emergency Certification was issued for 116 Pleasant Street for a garage
- 105 that was condemned due to a fire. The Agent stated that the building will be razed, but the
- 106 foundation will remain in place.
