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## SEWER WORK NOTICE

The Town of Ashland is conducting a sewer study to locate sources of stormwater entering the sanitary sewer system. The Town, in conjunction with their engineering consultant Haley Ward, Inc., has contracted with Flow Assessment Services, LLC to conduct dye test investigations in the following locations:

The testing involves putting a non-toxic, non-staining dye into downspouts, area drains, window well drains, stairwell drains, and driveway drains. The field representatives will then monitor the stormwater pipes and sanitary sewers in the street to confirm proper connections to the stormwater system.

If this testing is scheduled to be completed at your home or business you will receive a written notice approximately 1 week prior to the start of work.

Please Note:

- 1) Testing will be conducted weekdays between 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM.
- 2) Testing at each property is typically completed within 20 minutes.
- 3) You are **NOT** required to be home when the dye testing is being performed.
- 4) Prior to testing the testing personnel will knock on your door to ascertain if you are home and to alert you of their presence. All Flow Assessment Services personnel carry photo ID badges.
- 5) Testing is scheduled to be completed by Flow Assessment Services' field crews between Monday, September 19, 2022 and Friday, September 30, 2022.
