Our wonderful forest is 600 acres of prime habitat. Many creatures besides us enjoy it. PLEASE RESPECT their privacy, and DO NOT interact with them!

REMEMBER when in the forest use common sense. Be smart and stay safe!

ALWAYS tell someone that you are going out there, and where you think you will be walking, and for how long.

ALWAYS wear sturdy shoes, plan ahead and wear the appropriate layers of clothing.

ALWAYS have noisemakers, a flashlight, and a cell phone in case you sprain an ankle and need to call for help. Dogs must wear their license & rabies tags at all times.

STAY on the trails at ALL times!

PRACTICE – Trails Etiquette – PACK OUT what you BRING IN!

LEAVE NO TRACE – Trash, Dog Deposits, and Food etc. Coyotes follow this trail out of the forest to our streets and houses where they find trash and food!

For Everyone's SAFETY and COMFORT – Please keep your dog (s) leashed at ALL TIMES! No Exceptions! ALL dogs must be licensed, & wear their tags at ALL TIMES!

Electronic Leash Collars are NOT considered leashes!

153-2 D. Trash Disposal, littering or other polluting is prohibited.

153-5 Violations and Penalties for A. Criminal or B. Non-Criminal disposition:

First Offense	One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)
Second Offense	Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00)
Third and Subsequent Offenses	Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00)
Each day or part thereof of violation of any provision of this chapter or such rules and regulations, whether such violation is continuous or intermittent, shall be construed as a separate and succeeding offense.	
Any person having police powers, the conservation officer, zoning enforcement officer or other person so designated by the town manager shall have enforcement powers under this paragraph.	

Chapter 87: Animal Control - 87-17 Running at large.

No person who owns or keeps a dog shall allow the animal to run free when not restricted to the premises of said owner or keeper. When off said premises, such dog(s) shall be leashed and curbed.
